RESOLUTION SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF APPROVED 2021 BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, by Resolution 20-0, the Board of Health adopted the Snohomish Health District's 2021 operating budget on December 8, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 budget reflects revenues and expenditures that support public health services throughout Snohomish County; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the year, unexpected expenditures arose that necessitate a budget amendment, primarily due to COVID-19 response activities and other miscellaneous adjustments; and

WHEREAS, an increase of \$9,097,928 of expenditures offset by increased revenues of \$16,884,799 results in a surplus in the previously balanced 2021 budget of \$7,786,871, which will increase the fund balance at the end of 2021; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase previously budgeted staffing from 108.1 FTEs to 194.85 FTEs, thus adding 86.5 temporary positions for the COVID-19 response through December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted to the Snohomish Health District Board of Health in RCW 70.46 and in the Charter of Snohomish Health District, the Board does hereby approve the budget amendments as shown in Exhibit A.
