WHEREAS, HCA and Receiving Party previously entered into a Data Share Agreement (DSA) to provide Access to Baby and Child Dentistry (ABCD) services to detect and prevent early childhood dental decay for engaging dentists in seeing birth to six year old and disabled six to twelve year old Medicaid eligible children and engaging local public health departments in outreach and case management, and;

WHEREAS, HCA and Receiving Party wish to amend the DSA pursuant to Section 14 to extend term, revise eligible children population, add definition;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree the DSA is amended as follows:

1. The Data Share Agreement term is extended from June 30, 2022 to June 30, 2024.
2. Section 1, Background is amended to read as follows:

1. Background

The Receiving Party has previously entered into a Contract with HCA, K2757, in 2018. The purpose of the Contract is to provide Access to Baby and Child Dentistry (ABCD) services to detect and prevent early childhood dental decay for engaging dentists in seeing birth to six (6) year old and disabled six (6) to twelve (12) year old Medicaid eligible children and engaging local public health departments in outreach and case management.

3. Section 2, Purpose of the DSA is amended to read as follows:

2. Purpose of the DSA

The purpose of this Data Share Agreement (DSA) is to identify, describe and protect the Medicaid data being provided by HCA from ProviderOne to the Receiving Party. The purpose for sharing the Data is for the Receiving Party to identify eligible ABCD clients in order to match them to a dentist, then provide client outreach to families with children under the age of six (6) and disabled children under the age of thirteen (13). Outreach will be done by making phone calls to families to assist with connecting the child to an ABCD certified dentist, and information regarding the ABCD program will be sent via mail. The Data will help identify and address family barriers to accessing oral health care.

4. Section 3, Justification and Authority for Data Sharing is amended to read as follows:

3. Justification and Authority for Data Sharing

The Data to be shared under this DSA are necessary to help Medicaid clients, children under the age of six (6) and disable children under the age of thirteen (13), in accessing oral health care.

42 C.F.R. 438.208 allows for sharing of PHI for coordination and continuity of care.

RCW 70.02.050 allows for disclosure without patient authorization on a need-to-know basis for the provision of health care to a patient, for health care education, or to provide planning for the provision of health care to a patient.

5. Section 4, Definitions, a new definition "Disabled" is added as follows:

"Disabled" means clients who are enrolled in the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA). The administration within the Department of Social and Health Services responsible for administering and overseeing services and programs for clients with developmental disabilities. Formerly known as the Division of Developmental Disabilities.


6. Schedule 1: Description of Shared Data is replaced in its entirety and attached herein.

7. This Amendment will be effective July 1, 2022 ("Effective Date").

8. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the meaning ascribed to them in the DSA.

9. All other terms and conditions of the DSA remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The parties signing below warrant that they have read and understand this Amendment and have authority to execute the Amendment. This Amendment will be binding on HCA only upon signature by both parties.

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Schedule 1: Description of Shared Data

Per K2757 Contract with HCA, the Contractor is to identify eligible ABCD clients and match them to a dental home, provide family orientation, assist with scheduling dental appointments, identify and address family barriers to accessing oral health care. The Data will be provided semiannually for the timeframe of July 2020 through June 2022, in an excel format transferred via Secure File Transfer (SFT). HCA will provide access to the Receiving Party.
