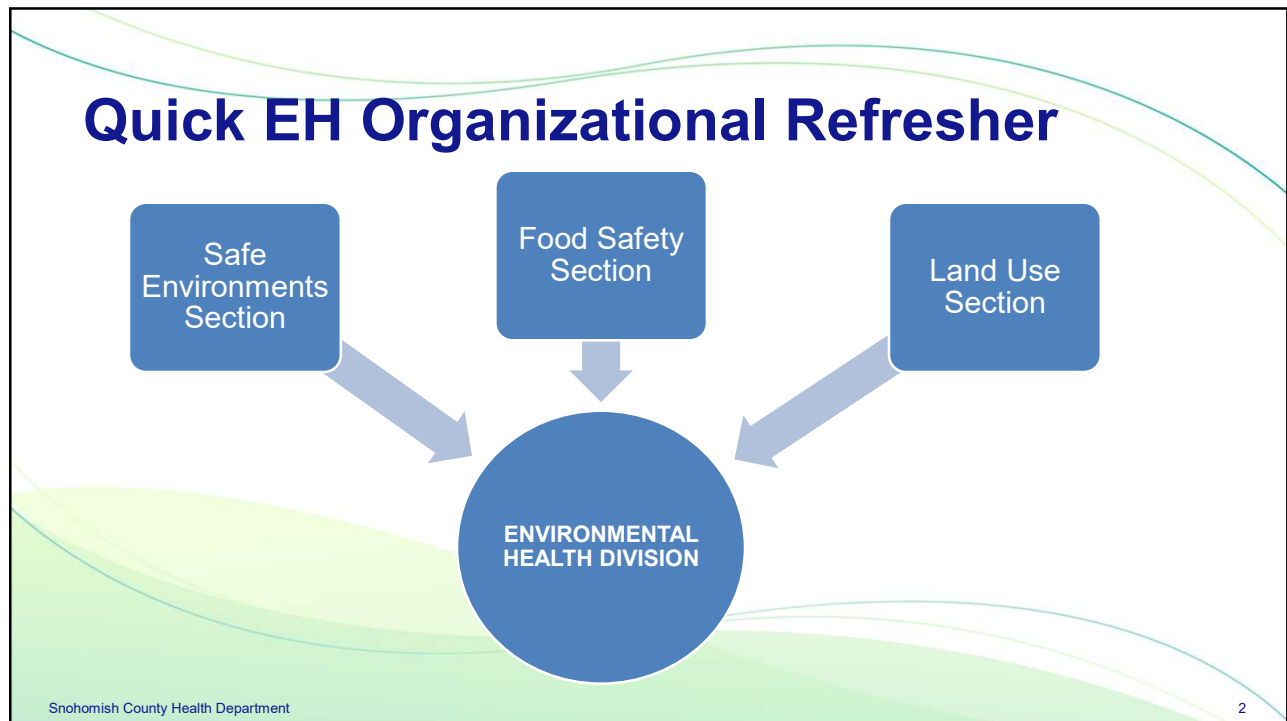

## How are we making this new code?

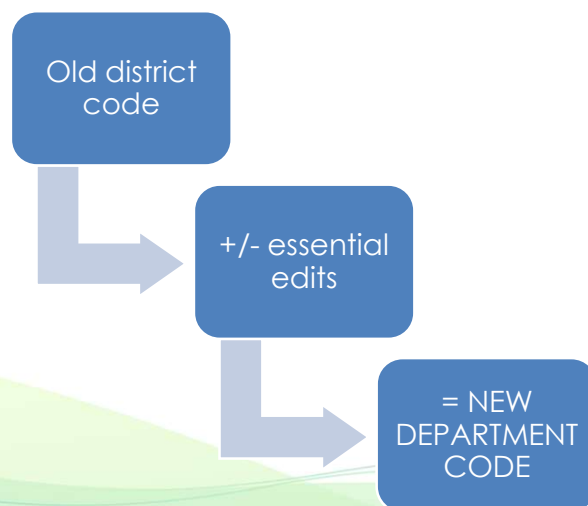
- Starting with District Code.

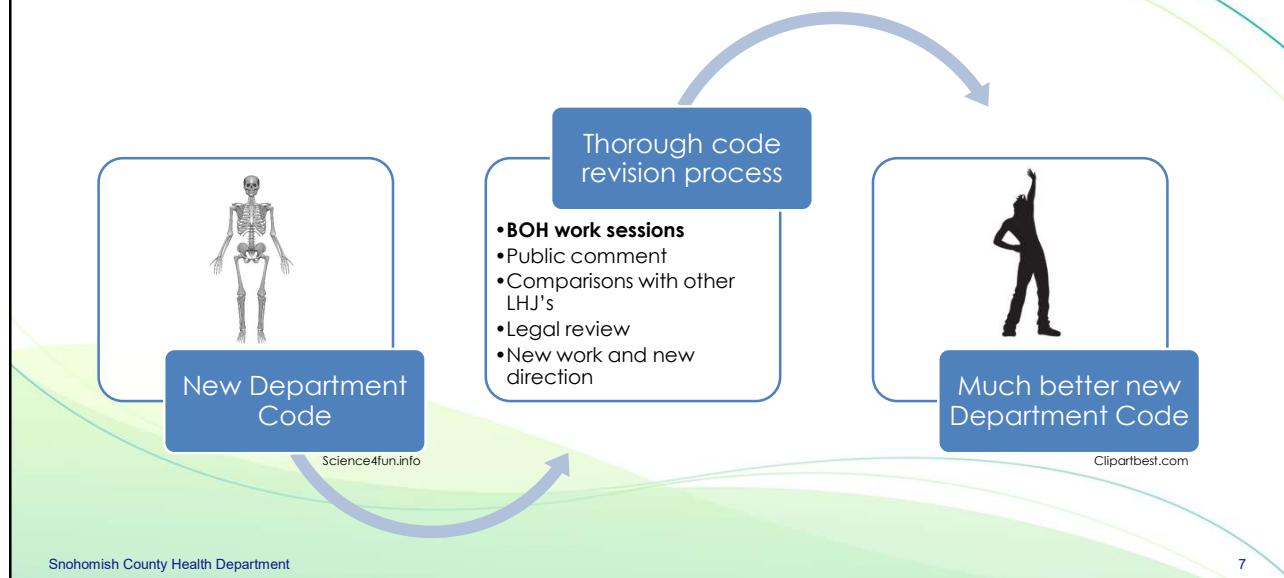

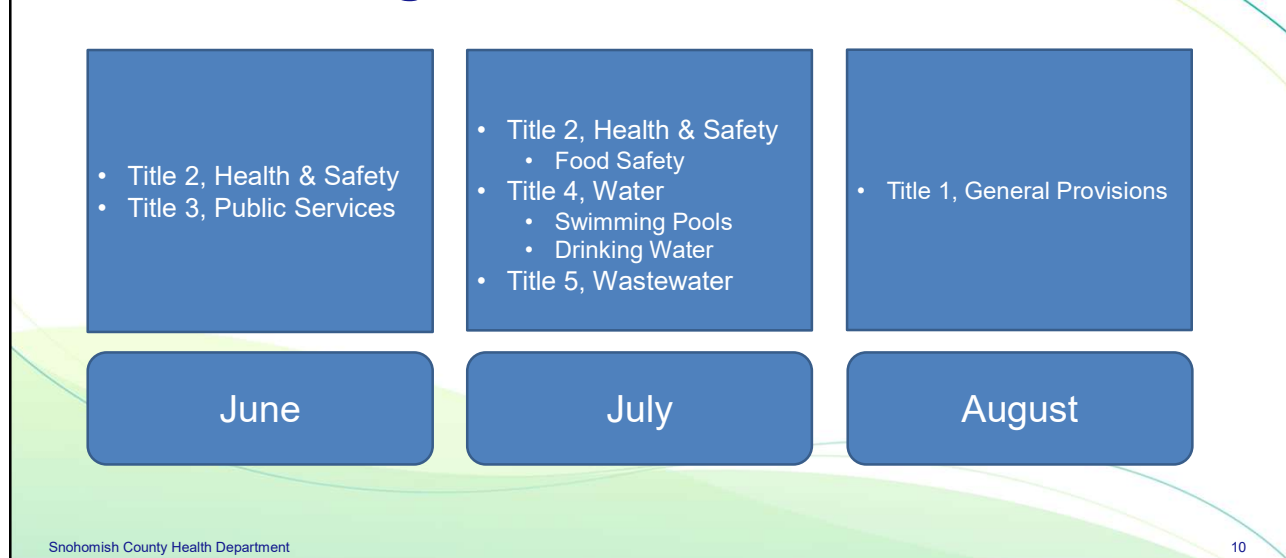
